TCV/HOA BOARD MEETING NOVEMBER 2, 2021 4:30 PM AT CAROLYN FUCHS

CALL TO ORDER:

The overall fees, excluding backyard resident mowing fees, for Landmark's services should finish 2021 within budget. Landmark is increasing the cost of lawn maintenance paid by the HOA next year. We also anticipate an increase in other HOA costs such as utilities and services due to the overall inflation; however we do not anticipate a need to increase dues for 2022. Motion to approve 2022 budget was made by Carolyn Fuchs, seconded by Darlene Demuth. MOTION PASSED.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE REPORT;

Darlene Demuth, Nominating committee chair, polled Board Members to determine who is willing to serve again in 2022. Darlene, Mike Bennett, and Carolyn Fuchs will

meet and survey residents who would be willing to come on board and serve. They will present a proposed slate for the 2022 Board the third week of November.
